**WHO MOVED THE PIANO ???**

There was a very excited preacher assigned to a new church. Upon his arrival he quickly began to meet with staff and leaders of his new church home. All agreed that changes needed to be made but as you can guess few of them shared the same ideas of change. Many had been in the church for years, grew up and raised their children there, in fact; and then there were others from everything between forever and just a few years; all having different experiences and memories of their time there. Then the Pastor and a few well-intentioned leaders decided that some of the changes needed were in the sanctuary, including moving the piano from one side to the other for better continuity and flow. Well the next Sunday, as you can well imagine, the moving of the piano caused quite a fuss; folks that had been there a long time said, (say it with me). "Why did you move the piano, it's always been over there; my grandmother played it there when I was a kid," Still others said, "I really liked it where it was, but I guess I'll get use to it." And still others said, "What's the big deal about moving the piano?"

Well as you can imagine the preacher's sermon and the wonderful piano-led music fell on distracted and even deaf ears that morning. The pastor wondered if Christ was even let into the room that day. The piano was returned to its original spot the next day. He spent the next week fielding options (that's what we'll call them here) and praying over what to do . Well, as all good preacher should, he prayed for guidance. It was about 30 days later, when One of his congregants came up to him after an amazing day of worship and said :Pastor that was a great sermon and Christ was truly in this place. But I have one question: how did you get everyone to agree to put the piano on the other side?" The pastor replied, "I have learned a lot over the years, but learned a great new lesson here in these past few months, that sometimes you have to move a piano an inch at a time.

Now that story has been told by many a clergy and differently I am sure. But I could not Help but think of us as Emmaus and Chrysalis Community and all the changes we were to make. All of us have had amazing experiences and Christ-filled moments when we reflect back on our years of service in the community. And there are those of us that will never like The changes. But I would ask that we react not as a congregation that sees the changes through our own eyes and experiences, but to be reminded that new pilgrims and caterpillars are not going to know we even had a piano in the room. I would ask that as we serve on these flights and walks in the coming months, that we allow Christ into the space to make music in hearts of those that need to hear it, and that we forget that the piano was never even on the other side of the room.
